Overview

Through the public utility company Instituto Costarricense de Electricidad (ICE), this flagship project will finance the construction and upgrade of transmission and distribution grids while supporting initiatives to promote renewable energy generation in Costa Rica. This stands out internationally and in the region. In 2019 the government passed a national plan to make Costa Rica one of the world's first.
