

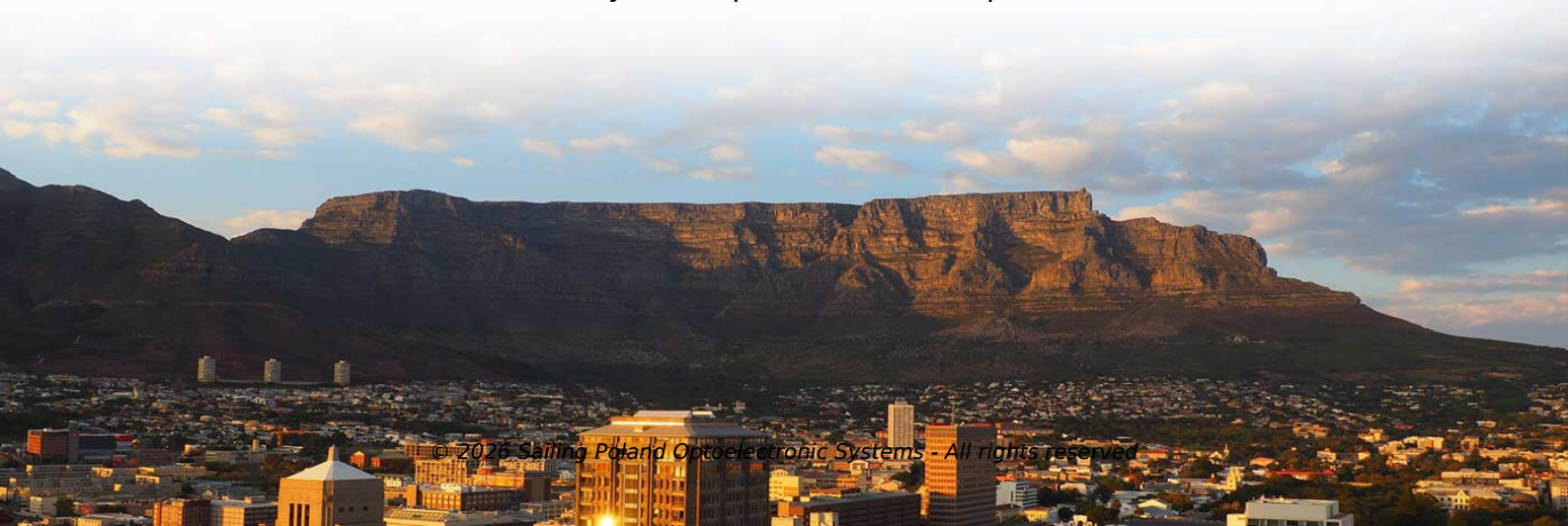
How to reserve fiber optic router space in a room
