Overview

The trays can be held up in two ways. The decision will be based on the location of where the wires are required to go: Wall Mounts: These are with Cantilever arms. These resemble an L, and they protrude from the wall to support the tray. Ceiling Mounts: With Trapeze Hangers. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray is used for instrumentation and control applications that require.
